Camping Rules

We're glad you're joining us for Furvaria 2026! To help everyone enjoy four relaxed days together, you'll find our camping rules here. Please read them carefully, and then you'll be ready to go.

The medical service is on site around the clock throughout the entire event, at least from Thursday to Sunday. It can be reached via Convention Security or by phone: **+49 1516 1664471**

1 Booking & Payment

- The campsite costs €150.00 per person for four nights, either Wednesday to Sunday or Thursday to Monday.
- Booking and payment are handled directly through Land-Steakhaus Bürger, not through Furvaria.
- Cancellation is possible up to 10 days before the start of the event, directly with Land-Steakhaus Bürger.

The camping price includes sanitary facilities (toilets and showers), on-site waste disposal, and access to the camping infrastructure. Power connections for vehicles are available only with advance registration. Please plan to bring your own power station if needed.

2 Arrival & Departure

- Earliest check-in: Wednesday, 10 June, from 14:00.
- Latest check-out: Monday, 15 June, by 12:00.
- Arriving later? No problem! You can check in until 01:30. The price remains the same regardless of when you arrive.
- Motorhome or caravan: please indicate this when booking. Electricity is available only with advance registration.

At check-in, you will receive your camping wristband, armband, or similar proof of access, along with a short briefing. The Furvaria team will be available at check-in for any questions.

3 Vehicles & Pitches

- Motorized vehicles of any kind (cars, motorhomes, etc.) are not permitted in the tent area of the campsite. The parking area is on the meadow directly next to it. Please carry your luggage on foot.
- Tent size: no fixed limit, but please use common sense. Set up what you need. Tent pegs, storm anchors, and similar equipment must not cause permanent damage to the ground.
- Vehicles and tents may only be parked or set up in the designated, marked areas.
- Please do not dig pits or holes... ;)
- Access to power and water connections must be kept clear at all times, including at night.

4 Access & Visitors

- Access to the campsite is permitted only for persons aged 18 or older.
- Anyone who has not booked camping may enter the campsite only when accompanied by a registered camper.
- Anyone who brings guests onto the campsite is responsible for their behavior, without exception. Violations by guests are treated as violations by the person who brought them.

5 Quiet Hours

- From 22:00: reduce noise levels. Please be considerate of neighbors and local residents. Loud music or loud conversations are not permitted.
- 00:00-07:00: night quiet hours. Absolute silence. Vehicles may not be operated during this time unless there is a compelling reason, such as a medical emergency.
- From 07:00 to 09:00, things may gradually become louder again. Please still be considerate of neighbors who are sleeping.

Many people return at 02:00 after a long evening. Please keep quiet!

6 Fire & Energy

Permitted:

- Gas cookers and gas grills. Please bring gas cartridges only in normal retail quantities and sizes. Do not leave them in the sun.
- Power stations and solar panels.

Prohibited:

- Open fires and campfires, except in areas specifically provided and explicitly designated for this purpose.
- Charcoal grills or disposable grills.
- Gasoline, diesel, or gas generators.

Charging options for power stations, power banks, phones, and tablets are available free of charge during the day in the main building. Please use only the designated charging stations or sockets.

No power connections are provided in the tent and parking areas. Anyone with greater power needs, such as lighting, coolers, or fans, should rely on their own power station.

Connecting devices to a power connection that has not been specifically booked, for example by using extension cables, is not permitted.

7 Waste & Hygiene

- Sanitary facilities (toilets, washbasins, and showers) are available on site.
- Waste containers are provided. Please separate your waste and dispose of it in sealed bags. This reduces odors and makes disposal easier.
- Greywater disposal is permitted only after consulting Land-Steakhaus Bürger. Please do not simply pour dishwater onto the ground or lawn.

8 Alcohol, Smoking & Other Substances

- Alcohol is permitted; resale is not allowed.
- Shisha is allowed in designated areas — please be considerate of other attendees and campers. Hot coals must be kept in fireproof

containers and may be disposed of only after they have fully cooled down.

- Smoking is permitted in designated areas.
- The use of narcotics is prohibited. The relevant legal regulations apply to the use of other recreational substances.

9 Strictly Prohibited

- Pyrotechnics of any kind, including fireworks, firecrackers, smoke flares, etc.
- Drones and other airborne objects.
- Weapons, including decorative weapons and replicas, unless Furvaria Security has classified them as harmless (“peace bonded” as defined by the Münchner Furs AVO*).
- Pets, unless they are strictly required by the participant, such as guide dogs for the blind as defined by the Münchner Furs AVO*.

10 Photos & Privacy

Before photographing or filming someone: ask first. Always. This also applies to fursuiters in the camping area — a fursuit is not a free pass for photos.

Taking photographs inside other people’s vehicles and tents is generally prohibited.

11 Camping with a Fursuit

- Your fursuits can be stored by Furvaria overnight. Please observe the separate conditions for this service.
- There is a fursuit lounge on the event grounds with air conditioning, snacks, and drinks for fursuiters.
- Charging options for batteries, fans, and similar equipment are available. Please bring the appropriate cables.

12 Safety & Emergencies

The medical service is on site around the clock throughout the entire event, at least from Thursday to Sunday. It can be reached via Convention Security or by phone: +49 1516 1664471

- In the event of conflicts or complaints, contact Security first; they will coordinate everything else.
- Emergency numbers 112 and 110 should be called only in genuine medical emergencies or acute danger. The on-site medical service is the first point of contact.
- Escape and rescue routes must be kept clear at all times. Keep sufficient distance from your neighbors, at least 1.20 m, and do not block entrances or exits.
- In severe weather, go to the main building immediately. Secure tents as far as possible.

13 Liability

- The organizer and operator are not liable for theft of or damage to your property.
- You are responsible for securing your valuables — do not leave anything lying around openly.

14 Rules & Sanctions

The instructions of Security and the organizing team must be followed.

The Convention Security monitors compliance with the camping rules and responds appropriately to the situation. Depending on the type and severity of a rule violation, measures may range from a simple reminder or warning to exclusion from the event.

In the case of serious violations, exclusion may also occur without a prior warning.

These rules are not meant to spoil your fun. They protect what makes Furvaria special: a weekend among friends where everyone feels safe and welcome.
